

Notice of Pending Application for Proposed Integrated Bank Treatment

Andrew Herold, 623 E. Main St., Arcadia, WI, 54612, has applied to the Department of Natural Resources for a permit to Riprap. The project is located in NW 1/4, NW 1/4, Section 32, Township 20N, Range 10W in Town of CROSS, Buffalo County.

Mr. Herold and Ms. Reedy are seeking a general permit for integrated bank treatment in the Town of Cross, Buffalo County. The project seeks to stabilize 420 linear feet along this shoreline to a 1.5 to 2 slope.

The Department will review the proposal provided by the applicant and any information from public comments and the public informational hearing. The Department will determine whether the proposal complies with ss. 1.11, 30.12 and 30.208, Stats., and ch. NR 150, Wis. Adm. Code, and ensure that the required mitigation meets the standards in s. 281.36(3r), Stats. if the project impacts wetlands.

The Department has made a tentative determination that it will issue the permit for the proposed activity. Any person may submit comments and/or request a public informational hearing by emailing Amanda.Minks@wisconsin.gov or writing to Amanda Minks, 101 S. Webster St. WT/3, PO Box 7921, Madison, WI 53707-7921 by U.S. mail. If you are submitting general comments on the proposal, they must be emailed or postmarked within 30 days after the date this notice is published on the Department's website. If you are requesting a public informational hearing, the request must be emailed or postmarked within 20 days after the date this notice is published on the Department's website. A request for hearing must include the docket number or applicant name and specify the issues that the party desires to be addressed at the informational hearing.


If no hearing is requested, the Department may issue its decision without a hearing. If a public informational hearing is held, comments must be postmarked no later than 10 days following the date on which the hearing is completed.

The final decision may be appealed as indicated in the decision document.
